**ORDINANCE NO. 2019-04**

**AN ORDINANCE OF EAST FALLOWFIELD TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, ESTABLISHING MULTI-WAY STOP SIGN CONTROLS ON CROSSING BOULEVARD AND MAGPIE LANE, MAGPIE LANE AND CORBIT WAY/SALMON LANE, NASSAU LANE AND SALMON LANE, AND MAGPIE LANE AND NASSAU LANE**

**BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST FALLOWFIELD AND IT IS ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE SAME:**

**Section 1.** Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, of the East Fallowfield Township Code, Section 15-213, Stop Intersections Established is hereby amended to incorporate the following additional stop sign intersections:

<b><u>Location</u></b>	<b><u>Type of Signal</u></b>
Crossing Boulevard and Magpie Lane	Multi-way stop control (all directions)
Magpie Lane and Corbit Way/Salmon Lane	Multi-way stop control (all directions)
Nassau Lane and Salmon Lane	Multi-way stop control (all directions)
Magpie Lane and Nassau Lane	Multi-way stop control (all directions)

**Section 2.** There shall be procured all official signs and signals, required under any of the Sections of this Ordinance or any future amendment hereof or additions hereto, which shall be erected, posted and maintained so as to properly give effect to the provisions of all of the sections of this Ordinance, and so as to properly comply with law, including the requirements set forth in the rules and regulations of the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

**Section 3.** This Ordinance shall be enforced in accordance with the provisions of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code as it pertains to fines and other penalties. Any person in violation of any of the provisions of any section of this Ordinance shall upon summary conviction be sentenced to pay such fines and in default of payment shall undergo imprisonment as shall be provided in the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code as now in effect or hereafter amended for summary convictions.

**Section 4.** Any provision of any prior Ordinance which may be in conflict with this Ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as a conflict may exist.


**Section 5.** Severability. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors of East Fallowfield Township that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section, or part thereof not been included herein.


**Section 6.** This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after its adoption.


