IN ATTENDANCE: Chris Makely, Chairman; Mark Toth, Vice Chairman; Chris Amentas, Member; Ed Porter, Member; Joe Pomorski, Member; Denise Miller, Township Secretary; Township Treasurer Rosemary Moore was absent.

MuniBilling update – Mr. John Yergey presented the Board with a breakdown of payments received for the 2013 trash and recycling. Mr. Yergey also stated that the cost feature has been fixed so that residents can see the cost they have to pay before they submit their payment.

P&RC (Chester County Grant) – Mr. Brian Carling asked the Board's consensus in putting the Brinton Station open space parcel under preservation at the county level. The Board agreed to do so and directed Mrs. Miller to put a motion on the February 26, 2013 agenda. Mr. Amentas asked Mr. Carling to explain how reaching the ten points works. Mr. Carling stated that there are several categories that can earn them up to twenty points each. Preserving the Brinton Station parcel will earn either ten or twenty points that will allow Park and Recreation to maximize their ranking, with a goal of getting as close to sixty points as possible, because the higher the points the better the ranking.

South Brandywine Middle School flashing warning device – This agenda item was previously omitted from the agenda.
