WHEREAS: It is vital that those affected by childhood cancer have access to quality, affordable care, and that research of all forms of childhood cancer continues to be vigorously supported; and

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of East Fallowfield Township hereby proclaim the week of October 9-15, 2022 as **CHILDHOOD CANCER AWARENESS WEEK** in East Fallowfield Township, and calls upon all citizens to join in activities that increase awareness and prevention of childhood cancer.
